- The **booth fee is \$85.00.**

- Arts and Crafts must be original. **“Buy/Sell” items, or artwork not created by the artist or crafter are not allowed.** Each entry form acts as a certification that the applicant’s work is original. Vendors who exhibit items that are not of their own creation will not be allowed to participate. Entry fees are not refundable.
- **Vendors who sell any food products must provide a photocopy of his or her Tulare County Environmental Health Food Permit.**
- **We are printing postcards and posters for distribution. You can help by letting us know how many posters and postcards you can use and the Arts Alliance will provide them to you.** Working together we can get information about the Redbud Festival to more people and sites than before. Place posters in teacher rooms, churches, businesses and work places and more! Postcards are available to send to your customers or to distribute at other events in which you participate.
