## FESTIVAL RULES

- The **booth fee is \$85**. Booth fees are non-refundable.
- Spaces are approximately 10" x 12".
- Each exhibitor is responsible for providing his or her own display, tables and chairs.
- All spaces, including those in the covered area, are available on a first come, first served basis. Each entrant is asked to provide his or her preferences for booth space on the entry form. Review the enclosed map or go to our website ([artsthreerivers.org](http://artsthreerivers.org)) to determine which space(s) you prefer. There is no guarantee on spaces, but we will do our best to accommodate your preference(s).
- Booths must be occupied for the full time of the show. Vendors must not begin packing up until 4:00 p.m. on Sunday.
- Vendors may set up on Friday from 2 p.m. to 7 p.m. or Saturday from 7 a.m. to 10 a.m. Vehicles must be removed from the immediate area by 9:45 a.m. on Saturday.
- Parking: Vendors should park in the upper parking areas behind and beside the covered area. Visitors will be directed to park below the arena area. Access to the upper area by the public will be minimized to reduce the amount of dust raised by the coming and going of shoppers.
- The Arts Alliance of Three Rivers assumes no responsibility for items left overnight.
- **All items must be handcrafted by the exhibitor. Manufactured or objectionable merchandise is not allowed.** Vendors who exhibit items not of their own creation must leave the festival. Entry fees will not be refunded.
- Vendors who sell any food products must provide a photocopy of her or his Tulare County Environmental Health Food Permit with their application.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting and paying California sales tax. A temporary permit can be obtained from the California State Board of Equalization. You may contact them at [www.boe.ca.gov](http://www.boe.ca.gov) or 800.400.7115.
- There will be a contest for the most remarkable booth. The winner will receive one free booth space at the 2009 Redbud Arts and Crafts Festival.
- A "Pick a Prize" raffle will be held to benefit the **Lorraine Young Memorial Scholarship Fund**. A donation of artwork for the fundraiser is appreciated. A representative of the Arts Alliance of Three Rivers will visit all booths Saturday morning to gather donations. Scholarships benefit local students pursuing careers in the arts.
